

## **Britain Yearly Meeting's All-together worship on Sunday 29 May 2022, 10:30 to 11:30am**

Lewes Meeting for Worship on Sunday 29th May will not take its normal blended meeting form. Instead, as agreed at our last MfWfCA, we will be joining Quakers across Britain in a huge "All together worship". This briefing sets out how this meeting will work.

"All together worship will be a huge meeting for worship, taking place across Britain. We will come together as a single, loving, inclusive and all-age community across the length and breadth of Britain Yearly Meeting. This unique meeting for worship will begin with a piece of creative writing. Over the last few weeks, a dozen young people aged 12 to 18 have been working with a facilitator on the theme of 'faith, community and action'. The piece of writing that's emerging from this collaboration will help us understand how faith, community and action fit together. We all have different senses of what this might mean, and by considering the theme in this way we hope to move towards discernment." Jessica Metheringham

You can participate in a number of different ways.

1. Attend the Britain-wide meeting at the Lewes Meeting House. Friends in the Meeting House will be fully part of the meeting, and will be able to offer ministry via zoom. We hope to set up a larger screen on this occasion to help Friends see what is going on. To participate, you simply need to turn up at the meeting house at the usual time.
2. Follow the Britain-wide meeting live on You tube. Alternatively you can watch the meeting online. With this option you will be sent a link to see and hear the meeting in real time on You Tube (a bit like a TV broadcast). You won't be directly connected to the meeting, so won't be able to offer ministry. To participate, you need the link and a computer. You will be able to follow the meeting either in real time or watch a recording of it later.
3. Participate in the meeting as part of your attendance at Yearly Meeting. If you have registered to attend yearly meeting in person, you will be able to join this meeting at Friends House. If you register to attend yearly meeting online, you will be able to join this meeting through your own zoom link. To participate, you need to register to attend Yearly Meeting by 20th May.
